NEW VARIETY - fast tracked for outstanding fruit quality, yields and flavour.



**Mid-late autumn, between Kweli – Kwanza.
Shows promise as a double cropping variety, producing
consistent high quality fruit, with a high yield potential.**



Excellent quality. Summer and Autumn crops are consistent in fruit size, shelf life and flavour. Maintains uniform appearance, without bleeding, after 7-10 days storage. scores highly in blind tasting events in autumn and summer



Fruit is presented well and deplugs easily for fast picking. Combined with good productivity and a large fruit size, Skye is economical to pick.



An attractive conical, berry; mid red in colour, with a high gloss. Flavour is sweet and aromatic with low acidity and vanilla notes. High brix^o.



Crops between 21 June – 2 August and 25 September – 28 October. Chill requirement is very low, similar to Kweli and Imara.



A tall, vigorous plant which produces straight long cane with short internodes which are well suited to double cropping. Canes produce a high number of fruit/lateral.

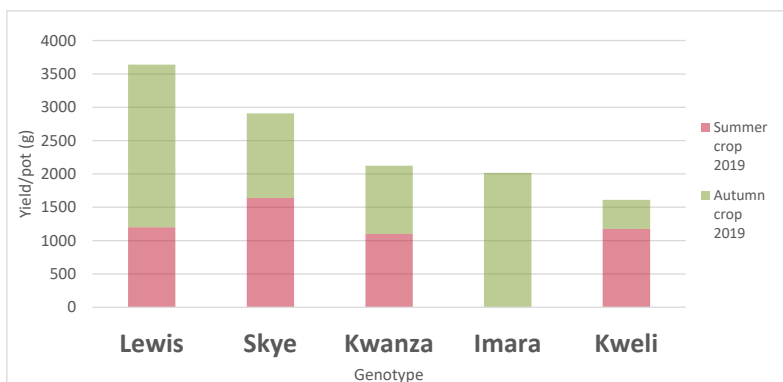
