

Glen Dee | florricane



A mid to late season florricane raspberry suited to long-cane production. Exceptionally high yielding and economical to produce.



Pale pink-red colour, shape is round to conic. Outstanding shelf-life. Maintains uniformity in storage and transports very well.



Mean Berry Size: 6.2g
Detaches easily from plug and quickly fills a punnet.



Sweet, fruity with a creamy texture and vanilla notes. Mean Brix° Level: 10.8°



Gene A10 confers resistance to most biotypes of raspberry aphid *Amphorophora idaei*.



Mid/Late season. Picking Duration: 5-6 weeks.
Cropping Period: Mid July- Mid August. Minimum 900 hours chill requirement.



Suitable for open field, soil grown or substrate.
Aim for 10,000 plants per Ha. 60cm short cane, 40cm long cane.



Spine free canes turn mid-brown in maturity. High root and cane vigour produces a high number of canes which display fruit well on strong laterals.
